

Trillions of cells


Each cell:

2 meters of DNA


3 billion DNA subunits (the bases: A, T, C, G)

AVERAGE AMOUNT OF SHARED DNA

- Child with parent: 50%
- Child with grandparent: 25%
- Child with great grandparent: 12.5%
- Child with 2 great Grandparent: 6.25%
- Child with 3 great Grandparent: 3.125%
- Child with 4 great Grandparent: 1.5625%
- Child with 5 great Grandparent: .07813%

MATCHING SEGMENTS


- Matching segments get shorter with each generation back
- Segments are measured in Centimorgans (cM)
- Segments under 5-8 cM might be coincidental matches
- Segments are identified by matching SNPs


