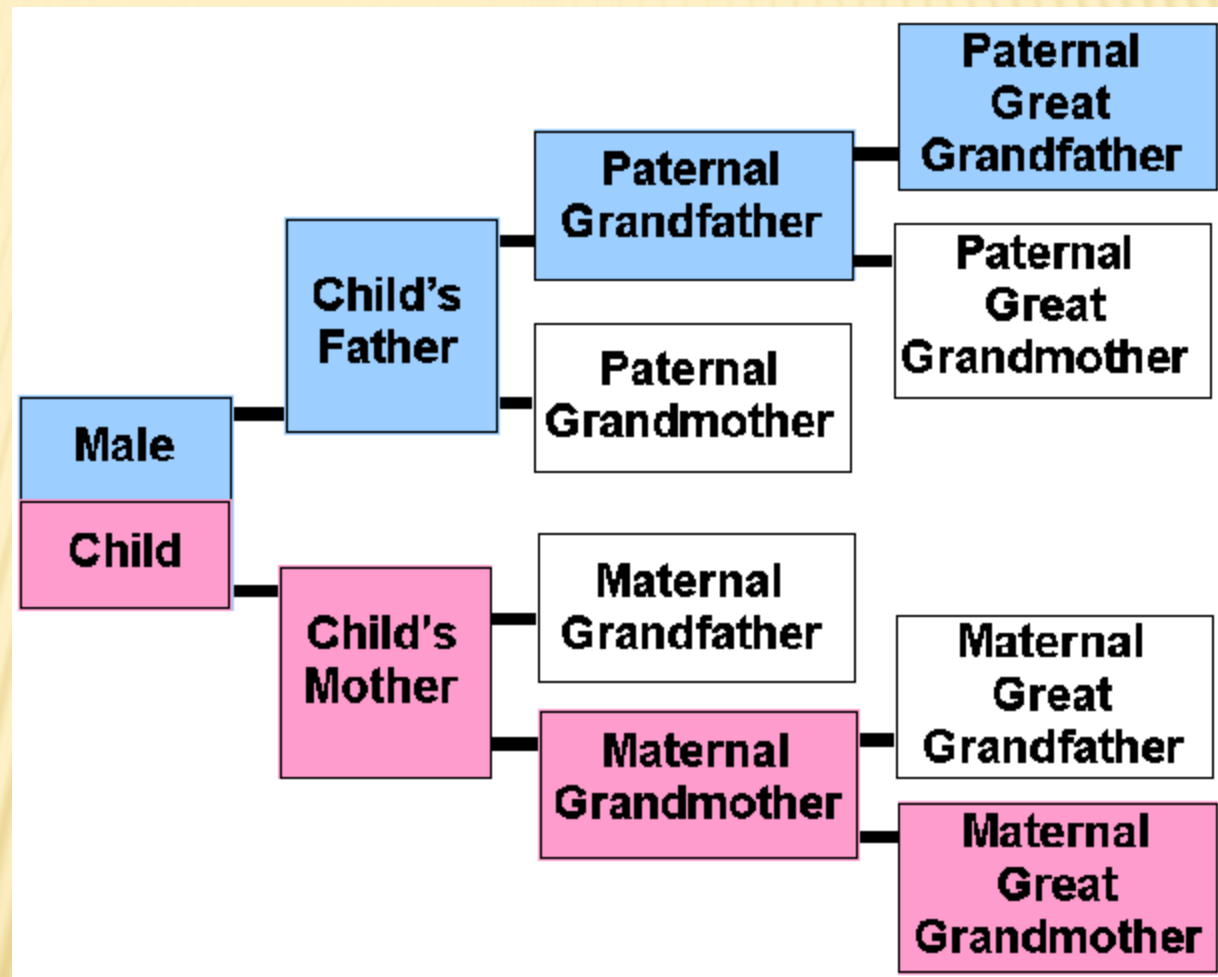

(pink)



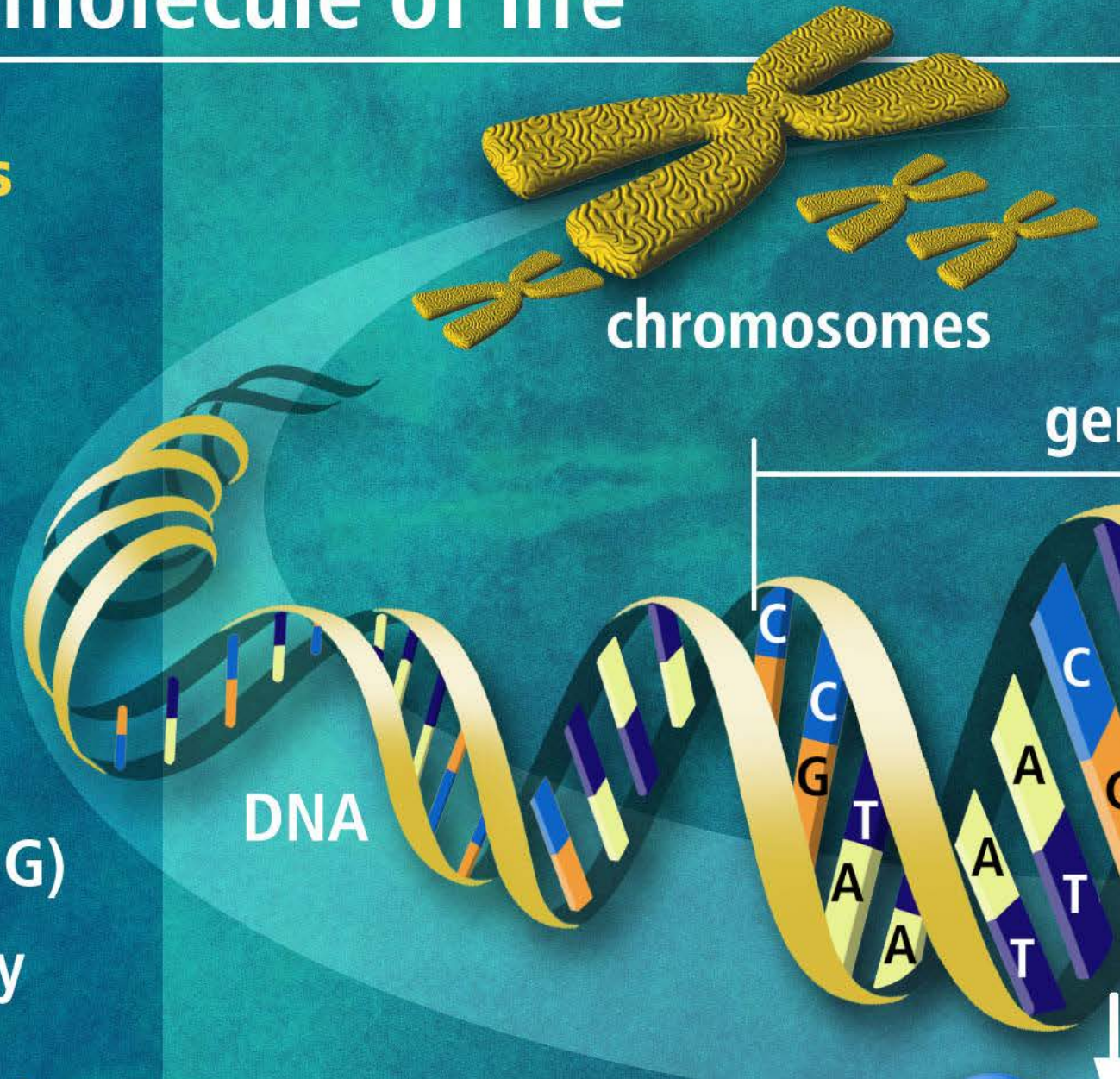


# DNA the molecule of life

## Trillions of cells

Each cell:

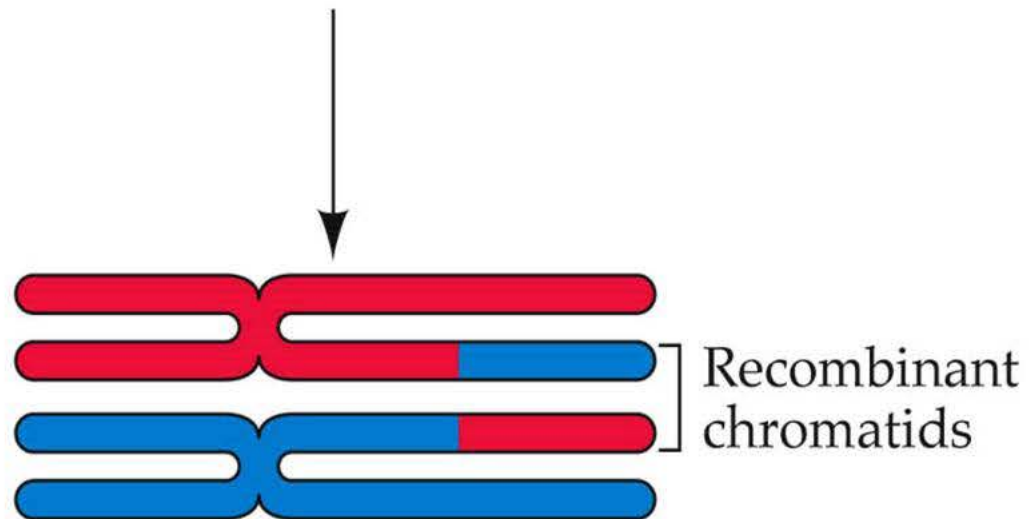
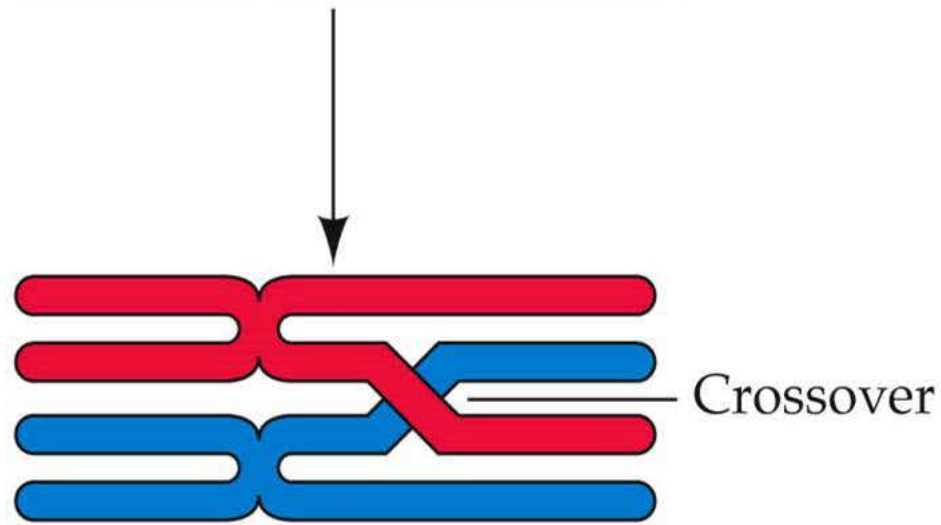
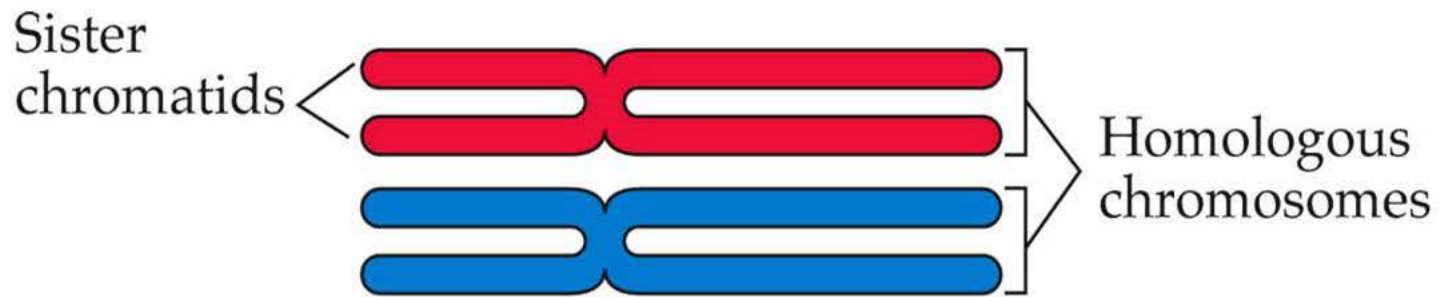
- 46 human chromosomes
- 2 meters of DNA
- 3 billion DNA subunits (the bases: A, T, C, G)
- Approximately 30,000 genes

# AVERAGE AMOUNT OF SHARED DNA

- ✖ Child with parent: 50%
- ✖ Child with grandparent: 25%
- ✖ Child with great grandparent: 12.5%
- ✖ Child with 2 great Grandparent: 6.25%
- ✖ Child with 3 great Grandparent: 3.125%
- ✖ Child with 4 great Grandparent: 1.5625%
- ✖ Child with 5 great Grandparent: .07813%

# MATCHING SEGMENTS

---

- ✖ Matching segments get shorter with each generation back
- ✖ Segments are measured in Centimorgans (cM)
- ✖ Segments under 5-8 cM might be coincidental matches
- ✖ Segments are identified by matching SNPs

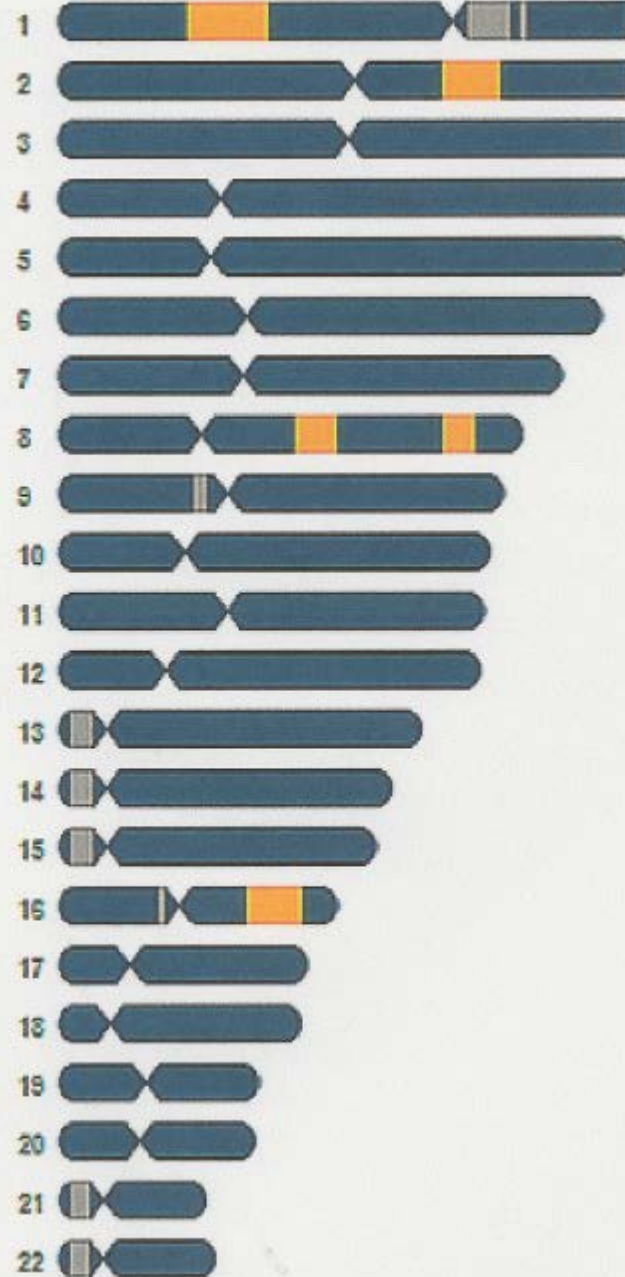
